Tuesdays: Total Body Tuesdays (Workout your entire body; physically & mentally)

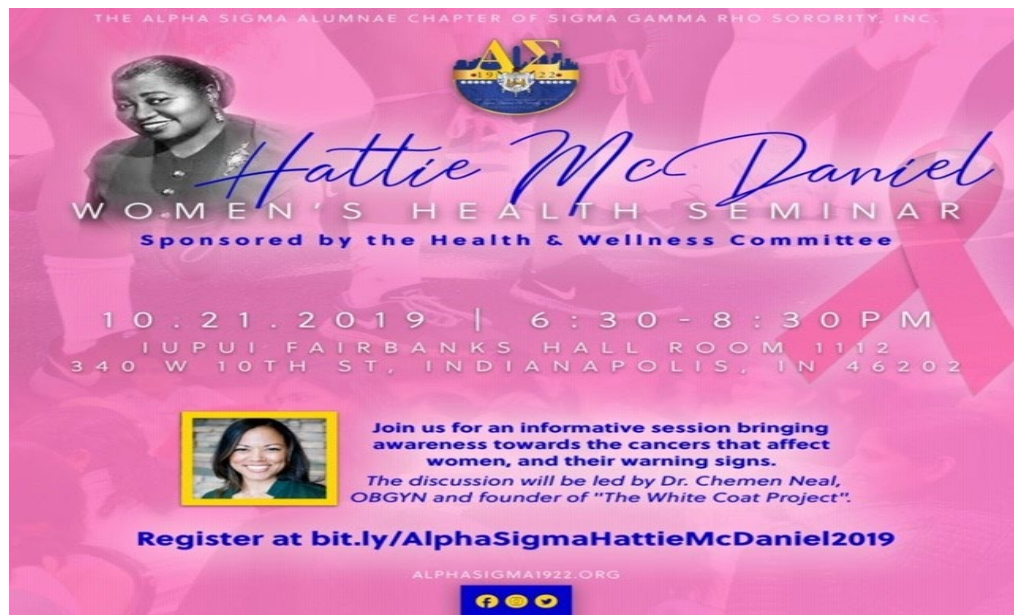
Wednesdays: Pump Day (Grab some weights or resistance bands to build muscle)
