What is your favorite Sigma memory?

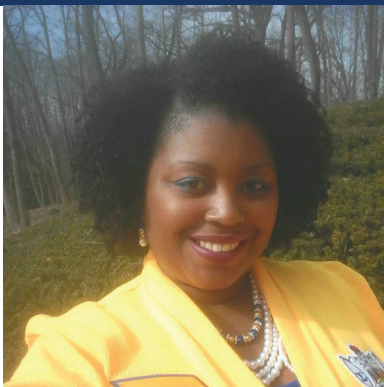
