Assessment & ICHQ Updates:

- Σ Dues are now due December 31st, 2020 on all levels. The last day to submit dues is Friday December 18, 2020. Late fees on a National and local level will be assessed after December 30th, 2020. If you have any questions about your balance or invoice, please see this Officer.
- Σ ICHQ Assessments are currently being submitted online via the submission portal. ICHQ has updated the portal so we can submit multiple payments at a time. The financial team is attending training on September 16 & 23, 2020. Please ensure to login to the Sorors only page on the International website to verify that your contact information is current. You have ability to change this information online. If you need to change the email address that is used for ICHQ list serve emails, you will need to call to have this updated.
- Σ Regional Assessments have increased from 20 to 30 dollars. You will receive an invoice if you have paid your dues in full for an additional 10 dollars; however, if you still owe you will see an increase by 10 dollars.

Payment Method Updates:

- Σ Remember that making dues payments directly from your invoice is available. Your invoice is automatically updated using this feature. This has been a very seamless process thus far and payments have been processed with no issues and no FEES.
- Σ Reiterating the importance of previewing any monies sent via PayPal before you press send. Triple check that "friends and family" is displayed on the final screen to avoid fees and needing to submit any additional monies. You can also pay directly through your bank with QuickBooks.

- 10% increase in membership or growth rate
- Utilized 83% of returning members as basis
- Total Income is 3.79M
- Primarily comprised of membership/dues.
- Expenses shown in #60000 encompass all things associated with headquarters.
- Utilities and building maintenance are shown with a 3% inflation factor
- Increased costs as the sorority heads towards Centennial, due to the additional events and associated travel.
- 20 Full Time Employees with a 3% merit increase.
- Insurance increased by 3%
- Meetings decreased by 74K (Covid, and virtual events)
- Additional information can be found in the footnotes
- \$3,779,472 is the proposed balanced budget.

Seven Pearls Report, Seven Pearls Foundation Report

The discussion was led by International Grand Basileus, Deborah Catchings-Smith, Executive Director, Deborah Hughes and Linette Caroselli, Seven Pearls President/CEO

Highlights of the discussion:

Linette Caroselli, Seven Pearls President/CEO had only been in office for five days when the letter came out. (Previous President: Sandra Hunt)

The \$200,000.000 loan in question is paid in full as of July 2020.

Since this loan caused so much confusion, the Seven Pearls Board of Directors opted to pay it in full.

The monies to pay off the loan was generated from Seven Pearls Gala's, Fundraising and product sales.

The loan was used to be in compliant with NC laws, maintenance and for requests by Cranial Technologies and/or tenants.

\$200K was used for: Roof, Compressor, Windows, Renovations and Ongoing Maintenance for the building (Details are included in the report)

All payments of the mortgage and the \$200K loan were on time, as Sigma Gamma Rho is the guarantor.

Sigma Gamma Rho is current with rent payments to Seven Pearls; and has, in effect, overpaid. When tenants rented out the building, it was understood that Sigma Gamma

Rho's monthly rental payment would decrease, however it has not. Retroactively, this resulting in over \$500,000.00 credit.
