Thank you for allowing this officer to serve as your Parliamentarian for the 2016-2017 sorority year. It has truly been an honor. Over the past year, the following recommendations were submitted and adopted:

The 2017 Special Boule Recommendations. The action item index which includes all adopted legislation can be found in the Sorors only section of the national website under member files.

Local Recommendations:

- Article V. Financial Obligations Section 501. Amended to read: Section 501. Local dues of \$150.00 shall be due by the end of July 1st meeting with a 90-day grace period for all members of Alpha Sigma.
- Article V. Financial Obligations Section 504. Current language removed.
- Article V. Financial Obligations Section 504 a. Current language removed.
- Article IV. Chapter Regulations Section 404. Delegates and Alternates a. Qualifications 3. Amended to read: 3. The elected delegate must have not missed more than 30% of the regular meetings during the sorority year. If the elected delegate has not met the 30% regular meetings during the sorority year requirement, the Basileus has the discretion to overrule this particular qualification if there are not enough elected delegates attending the conference.
- Art. IV. Chapter Regulations. Section 404. Delegates and Alternates. C. 1. Language was delete from current section and move current language to Article VI Officers. Section 606 Executive Board. Add d.
- Article IV. Chapter Regulations. Section 404. Delegates and Alternates d. Incentives. 1. Amended to read: Incentives: Along with required quantity of delegates needed, the Basileus is included in the count for incentives given to a delegate whether or not she is acting as chapter delegate.

- Article IV. Chapter Regulations. Section. 405 Quorum. Amended to read: Quorum. A quorum for the transaction of business by Alpha Sigma shall consist of three elected executive officers and one-third of the financial membership.
- Article IV. Chapter Regulations. Section 406 Meetings. g. Capitalize Executive Board throughout.
- Article V. Financial Obligations. Section 503. Regional Dues a. Amended to read: A late fine of \$10 will be assessed if dues are not paid on or before the September meeting.
- Article IV. Chapter Relegations Section 406. Meetings a. Amended to read: Alpha Sigma shall meet on the third Saturday of each month, except for the months of June and December unless otherwise specified. For implementation for the 2018-2019 Sorority Year.
- Article V Financial Obligations. Section 502 a. Amended to read: a. Alpha Sigma Chapter will assess a late fee of \$10 if dues are not paid on or before September 30. The national late fee of \$10 will be assessed if dues are not paid on or before September 30. National and Regional late dues will be submitted no later than January. Sorors have the option to pay in installments to meet financial obligations.
- Article IX Elections Section 901 Elections of Officers. Amended to read: The election of officers shall take place every two years in May of the Biennial Boule year. Notice of newly elected officers shall be sent to National Headquarters and filed in Alpha Sigma's records. For implementation for the 2018-2019 Sorority year
- Article IX Elections Section 901 Elections of Officers. a. Amended to read: The Nominations Committee shall post offices available at the April meeting. For implementation for the 2018-2019 Sorority year.
- Article IX Elections Section 901 Election of Officers. b. Amended to read: Candidates must submit a letter of intent and a candidate's application by April 30 of the election year. For implementation for the 2018-2019 Sorority year.
- Article IX Elections Section 901 Election of Officers. c. Amended to read: The Nominations Committee will read the names of the Sorors running for office at the May meeting. For implementation for the 2018-2019 Sorority year.
- Article IX Elections. Section 901. Elections of Officers.d Amended to read: d. Voting will take place at the May meeting of every other year. For implementation for the 2018-2019 Sorority year.
- Article IX Elections. Section 901. Elections of Officers.e Amended to read: All officers shall take office at the July Executive Board Meeting. For implementation for the 2018-2019 Sorority year.

78th Central Region Conference Recommendations. The final dispositions were included in the delegate's report that was sent out.

Today the chapter will vote on the 2018 Boule Recommendations, which were sent out for review in May 2018 and attached to the composite file. There will be a motion made to bundle the adopted recommendations and vote on those with no recommendations or postpone indefinitely due to time.
